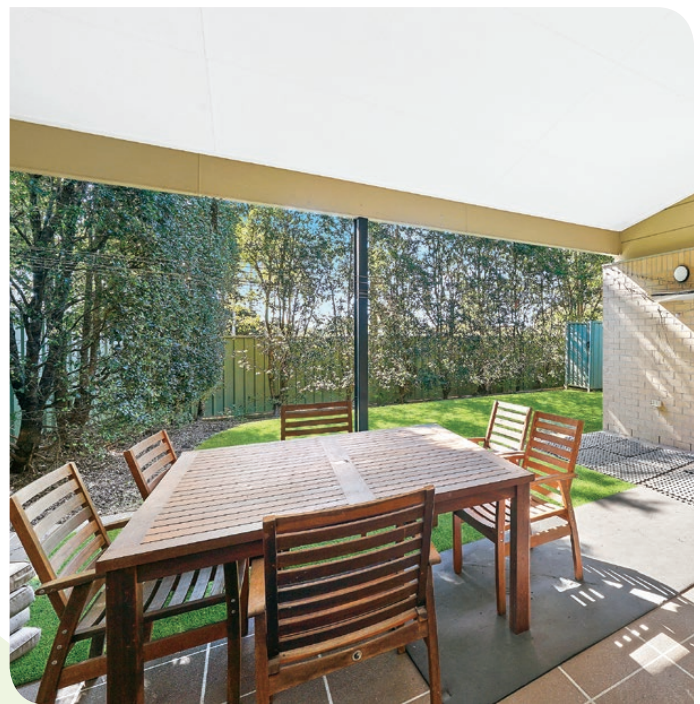

With SDA, you won't have to pay more for accommodation just because you have special needs. Our approach is to provide safe, quality care in a place you can call home.



Supported Independent Living

Ability Options provide accommodation services for over 100 people from a wide range of age groups living in NSW. We offer a range of service models ranging from units to purpose built houses and group homes with 24 hour support. Our services also work in partnership with Government agencies like Housing NSW and community housing providers to assist people to find a suitable home and support to maintain a public housing tenancy.

Our Outreach program assists people to develop independent living skills and some other longer-term service users with minor levels of assistance, to manage their household and live independently. At Ability Options we are dedicated to providing advice and accommodation options for people with disability across NSW.

GST exempt (excluding transport services).

To ensure quality of care and under NSW Fair Work, our carers can only work a maximum of 10 hours per day and 38 hours per week.

Cancellation Policy and Fee

- 1 hour charge for a service that is 1 hour and cancelled within 4 business hours of start time of the service
- Full service charge for a service that is less than 2 hours and is cancelled within 4 business hours of the start time of the service
- 2 hours charge for a service that is more than 2 hours and is cancelled within 4 business hours of start time of the service
- All cancellation requests made outside the business hours will attract cancellation fees charged as follow: 1 hour charge for a service that is 1 hour
- Full service charge for a service that is less than 2 hours
- 2 hours charge for a service more than 2 hours.

Business hours are from 8am to 5:30pm Monday to Friday (excluding Public Holidays)
