How it works

We will meet with you and your family or carers to discuss your needs and the things you like to do. This is so we can create a respite plan that works best for you all. The plan covers all your health and safety needs, preferred routines and any activities or trips that you would like to take part in during your stay.

Is it for me?

If you are aged between 7 and 65, have a disability and are looking for a short break then we can support you.

Emergency accommodation is also available on request. This is dependent on availability and your individual requirements.

How much does it cost?

Our overnight fees are in line with the NDIS Price Guide. You can obtain a copy of the Guide from our Respite Coordination Liaison Officer.

If you do not have access to NDIS funding then you can pay for your stay yourself. Private fees are in line with the NDIS fees.



Our staff enjoy preparing fresh, varied and nutritious food in the large, well-equipped kitchen. You are welcome to join in with meal preparation, if you wish.

We have a fully accessible van for day trips, picnics or outings in the local area. Situated in the centre of Port Macquarie, the house is only a few minutes drive from the beach, shops and cinema.

We offer a range of services and activities at the house. If you want to take part in any special activities or events we will do our best to organise this for you.

What can I do in the Port Macquarie?

What support can I get in the house?
